40,000 TRAINED

This summer, we trained our 40,000th conservative leader during a small training in Minneapolis, Minnesota. That means there are 40,000 grassroots activists who now have the tools to implement the conservative, generational change our nation needs. While we are honored to have worked with 40,000 leaders, we know we must continue the fight and equip as many conservative activists as possible to counter the liberal machine. We will continue to arm activist with the tools they need. We will not be slowing down anytime soon.

NEW MINNESOTA OFFICE

With three battleground congressional districts, two U.S. Senate seats, and a governorship up for grabs, 2018 will be a big year for the conservative movement in Minnesota. ONLINE AMERICAN MAJORITY TRAINING

American Majority has offered online training for Activists and Candidates since 2015. Our courses are fully online, accessible anywhere, distance education for candidates and activists. With more than a dozen offerings ranging from Researching and Planning Your Campaign to Activate Your Campus to the free mini-course, Should You Run for Office?, American Majority Online is filling a need to have our quality courses accessible anywhere a student lives, works, or travels.

American Majority Online has increased its number of students from 35 last year to 264 students in 2017. As in American Majority's in-person trainings, AM Online currently offers 12 free courses to students contemplating a career or volunteerism in politics.

Like American Majority's in-person trainings, AM Online seeks to improve involvement in politics around the country by training conservative candidates and activists in the nuances of planning and running a successful campaign.

If Trump wants to drain the swamp, Ryun suggests, he should start with an executive order to "lay down stronger guidelines, standards and practices as to how his Executive Branch and Cabinet members spend taxpayer dollars." It would rein in future administrations, too: "There will be hell to pay for any president who might revoke that order."

American Majority New Leaders were highly successful in Wisconsin's 2017 spring elections. Twenty-one out of 26 (80 percent) won their races after training with American Majority. Thirty-three percent of the winners won seats on their local school board this cycle.

A highlight of the spring election cycle was first time candidate Lee Webster winning a seat on the Wausau School Board. This past year, he has been a common sense voice who has improved the school district with his service.

American Majority works to build a farm team of New Leaders at all levels of government. Our trained New Leaders include village presidents, village trustees, city aldermen, and school board members. The farm team builds from the local and state levels of government. These leaders are also the folks who will hopefully take the next step to run for higher office and further the conservative movement.

Since opening our Wisconsin office in October 2010, we have trained 159 new leaders who've gone on to victory across Wisconsin.

In August, the Minnesota field office reopened with a strong start. The team held 24 trainings throughout the State and increased awareness of American Majority trainings and online course offerings. The team also held the 1st annual Upper Midwest Leadership Summit, which was a daylong intensive training on campaign operations and policy updates.

Our 2018 plans include continuing to grow our statewide grassroots and candidate training program and outreach efforts. The start of these efforts begins with the launch of the 2018 statewide caucus-training program. Seventeen trainings have been scheduled in January to launch this effort, which will encourage conservatives to turn out early and get involved in the election process. During this caucus training effort, the team will also be working to identify candidates to train to run for local, legislative and federal offices across the state.

Minnesota Executive Director Jennifer DeJournett said, "Minnesotans remember the strong, positive presence that American Majority had in the State in the 2008/2010 cycle. Grassroots leaders and candidates across the state are thrilled that American Majority is back, building a stronger grassroots base and growing the next generation of leaders."

American Majority Colorado has increased its number of trainings and reach in 2017 over last year. We have given intense focus to local candidates and local government from both the candidate and activist side. We held several local government trainings focused on identifying new leaders for boards and commissions in conjunction with Independence Institute, and many of these New Leaders now hold positions

within their communities. Our biggest increase this year has been in our number of candidates trained, especially those seeking city council, county commissioner, and state legislative office. Colorado needs a more solid conservative farm team to combat the Left. Our hope is that both our local government trainees and potential candidates will continue to utilize American Majority Colorado trainings to equip themselves for higher office.

This year, we have also expanded our geographical reach in Colorado, holding four trainings in Fort Collins, three in Colorado Springs, one in Pueblo, and a tour of trainings on the Western Slope of Colorado-an area often neglected by the conservative establishment in Colorado. We continue to seek out training opportunities not only in Denver, but in rural counties as well.

CAMPAIGN-IN-A-DAY

This year, American Majority has seen the take-off of its interactive training Campaign-In-A-Day. In 2017, we had nine events, training 487 students so far. The Campaign-In-A-Day experience has given attendees the ability to put what they are trained on into action the very same day. Participants are



tasked with creating a plan and then defending it later in the day in front of a panel of experienced political judges. This one-of-a-kind American Majority training is not only educational, but is also competitive as well as able to bring in a sense of camaraderie amongst trainees.
